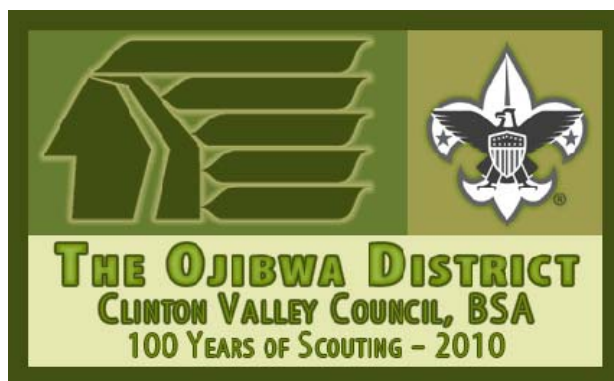
Camp-o-ree Features

We will also award the Coup Stick to the most spirited Troop at the Camp-o-ree.



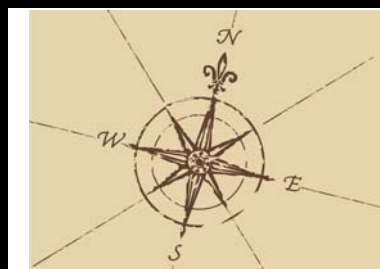
